Our Programs



Nursery Up to Age 3 1/2

. Nursery is free play in a safe space with familiar people each week!



Spirit Play Pre-K and K

A Montessori- based classroom, where children hear stories focused on UU principles and sources and then break out for independent "work."



Grades 1-2 Moral Tales

Every day our children go forth into a complex world where they are often faced with difficult decisions and situations. Moral Tales attempts to provide children with the spiritual and ethical tools they will need to make choices and take actions reflective of their Unitarian Universalist beliefs and values.



Grades 3-4 Windows and Mirrors

Windows and Mirrors nurtures children's ability to identify their own experiences and perspectives and to seek out, care about and respect those of others.



Grades 5-6 Popcorn Theology / Lessons of Loss

In Popcorn Theology, we explore life's big questions utilizing PG-Rated movie excerpts with a message. Exploration is through activities and discussion. In the

Spring, we move to a 5 week curriculum called Lessons of Loss. Participants discuss loss, death, and discovering that life and death are both part of a journey that can be honored and accepted. We have field trips and learn about other cultures



Grades 7-8 Coming of Age

Coming of Age is a UU rite of passage program which incorporates self-reflection/ team building/ mentored learning/ challenges/ interaction with UU community/outreach/fun. Participants must sign up before September and commit to the program and have a mentor.

Grades 1-2 OWL

Our Whole Lives- Sexuality Education. This year grades 1-2 will be offered 6 weeks of OWL during the morning RE times. OWL is designed to help children gain the knowledge, life principles, and skills they need to express their sexuality in life enhancing ways. This curriculum is an expression of the belief that religious communities, community organizations, and schools, can form meaningful partnerships with parents to provide positive and responsible sexuality education.
