The Childcare Space ages 0-4 years

In The Childcare Space, our little ones listen to stories, sing songs, and have fun playing with their friends.



Explorers (gr k-4)

Using materials from Soul Matters and UU curricula, children explore topics such as heritage, generosity, justice and equity, and interdependence. Each week's gathering includes a chalice lighting, check-in, story, discussion, activity, and closing words. We encourage children to explore their own big questions. All of our programming aligns with the principles and sources recognized by Unitarian Universalists.



Builders (gr 5 & 6)

Children in this age group will explore the monthly themes which align with our UU Principles plus additional special programming.

The Unitarian Universalist 7 Principles

1. Honor the inherent worth and dignity of every person.
2. Practice justice, equity, and compassion in human relations.
3. Accept one another and encourage spiritual growth.
4. Support the freedom to search for what is true and right in life.
5. Ensure all have a vote about matters that concern them.
6. Work for a peaceful, fair, and free world.
7. Care for planet Earth, the home we share with all living things.



Coming of Age (gr 7 & 8)

The COA program is a UU rite of passage experience which incorporates self-reflection/ team building/ mentored learning/ challenges/ interaction with UU community/outreach/fun. By the final service, each participant will be able to answer questions that are true to themselves (at that moment in their lives): Who Am I? What Do I Care About? What Do I Believe? What Do I Want to Stand Up for In the World?



High School Youth Group (gr 9-12)

Sunday evenings 6-8pm Youth Group gives our high school youth the opportunity to come together for fun, community service, outreach, discussions, worshipful experiences and interaction with other youth groups.
